The way I see it this parrot flew thru the rainbow when it was wet! Or just maybe God in His handwork added just the right DNA for colors!


Our time here in Santa Cruz is coming to an end once again. For sure lots of rain, a huge crop of mosquitoes and the dengue fever.

Several of our goals for this trip were done. Many thanks to prayer warriors and financial gifts to accomplish this outreach.

**Goal number one** was to finish the video, "The Gospel of John" in the Chimane language.

**Goal two** was to get the finished video, " The Gospel of John" to the Chimane people.

We are very pleased with the finished copy. Now for the Chimane folks to enjoy the film and grow spiritually in the Lord.



**Goal three** was to purchase solar radios and get them out to the Chimane people. Our goal was to purchase 50. We settled for 40 that were of a little better quality. We sent them out with 250 flash drives with Bible programs on them. These were sent out and have arrived just ahead of a huge rain storm.





The Chimane women have been working hard on recording programs for the ladies. Now they can listen to their hard work all day long if they want to.



**Goal four** was to see the Chimane Conference building going up. Pictures hardly show all the work it takes to build a building. Trees have to be found, cut them down, cut them up, haul them, get the wood up before it dries and curves the lumber. Next paint the wood for bug control, dig holes, all the while using all the fancy tools we use to build a building. "Right!"

The floor will be raised up a couple feet as flooding during raining season is common.



**Goal number five** was the final check of the "Gospel of John" in the Ayore language.

These dear folks have been faithfully recording over 800 audio clips for this film this past year. It finally reached the stage where they needed to sit and listen to all the clips in the video. If it passes

their test with six people listening it stands a good chance of being right. It still faces another quality check by JAARS who render it all together and make a finished copy. Lots of work, but the results will give a huge tool for the Ayore people. A visual of the life of Christ. This is a very well-done video that would touch anyone's heart from the Gospel of John.



I think that about winds it up for this trip. Thanks for your prayers and support for this outreach. Just to fill in some down time we got started with another tribal language group called the Guarayos. So much fun listening to a new language!
